

In **Taichung**, we developed with engineering partner Buro Happold, a 62.000 m2 Cultural Center organized around a public space that unfolds into Gateway Park. The building is conceived as a continuous cultural twist that combines the virtues of both museum and library, maximizing interdisciplinary exchange while preserving autonomy. BUENOS AIRES ARCHITECTURE BIENNIAL




